SICKNESS

Recently we have had a number of children attending the centre who have been unwell.



When we have notified parents they have continued to bring children, whilst they have been unwell. This is unfair to children, families and staff. Attached to this newsletter is the centre policy for sickness. We ask that all families view this policy and comply with the centre guidelines.

1. Children who are unwell are NOT to attend the centre.
2. Parents are asked to care for their child at home and return them to the centre once they are well. Parents may be required to produce a doctor's certificate as clearance prior to the child return.
3. Parents are asked to collect their child IMMEDIATELY if notified of illness to reduce the spread of infections in the centre.

With the winter months steadily approaching cold's and flu like symptoms will certainly increase. We ask that parents are not offended by this policy, but rather are appreciative that the centre holds the interest of all children, families and staff.

We ask that parents are considerate to others families, children and staff. WE ask that you assist us by complying with centre policies so that we can reduce illness to staff who ultimately can for your child.

It is a Health and Safety requirement that all families provide children with sleeping needs. this means all children in the Bees and Possums Room require :

1. A Fitted sheets and Flat sheet.
2. A small comfort rug if required.

If families do not provide these we will charge families \$15.00 per week for use of sheets.
